### Resurrection Life

Sermon by Pastor Zach Prosser

- Read/review 1 Kings 17
- Pastor Zach said of Elijah, “Even in the day of wickedness, the day of evil, God put his hand on his man and used him in spite of the situation.”

How does this encourage you? Have you experienced “days of wickedness” and had God use you anyway? What did it teach you?

- Read John 7:37-38
- It what ways have you been “thirsty”? How does Jesus satisfy that thirst (or do you still struggle to let him do so)?
- Pastor Zach said, “When you begin to give away what the Lord’s given to you, he refills it all the time. If you will begin to sow your seed, he’ll refill it. He’ll refresh it. You may feel like it’s insignificant: give it away. God will multiply it.”

When have you experienced God’s provision even when you didn’t think there would be enough?

- When the widow’s son became ill and died, the widow began to doubt God’s provision despite all that he had done so far. The true issue was exposed: her heart was sick. She had not truly sacrificed her disbelief, and reverted to her old mindset.

Has God ever used one issue to expose something much bigger or deeper in your heart?
