What's that Smell?

Sermon by Pastor Zach Prosser

- Read Amos 4:1-13
- To a holy, perfect, and sinless God, our sin, no matter how "small" it
 may seem to us, has a rotten stench. That stench rises to God and
 seeps into every area of your life, though your own pride may keep
 you from sensing it.

Why does pride get in the way of "smelling" our own sin?

- The rotten smell of sin comes from spending time with the enemy and living in sin. Likewise, spending time with the Lord will cause his fragrance to rub off on you. God demands holiness of us, and being in his presence forces us to confront the sin in our lives.
 - During this season of revival in our church, what issues have you noticed coming up in your life? What sin is God bringing to your awareness?
 - Why do you think revival brings with it so much conviction of our sinfulness?
 - How can you begin to rid yourself of the stench of sin?
