The Righteousness of God

Sermon by Pastor Zach Prosser

- Read Romans 1:16-17; Psalms 111:3
- Psalm 7:11-13 describes the righteousness of God as a powerful force of wrath against sin. As sinners, Pastor Zach explained, we deserve the wrath of God. But thanks to Christ's sacrifice, we are covered by God's grace and are saved from this wrath. But those outside his grace are not.

Take a minute to think or talk about what it is like to be outside God's grace and unprotected from his wrath. How does this influence your feelings toward Christ and toward those who are not believers?

- Read John 1:14
- Jesus Christ came to earth as man—"the Word made flesh"—and lived among us so we could see his glory. He also came full of "grace," or joy—he came willingly, delightedly, to show himself to us. David prays in the Psalms for the Lord to restore that same joy, the "joy of his salvation."

Do you remember a time when you lost the joy of your salvation? What restored it? How does knowing Jesus came to us joyfully and willingly influence your joy?
