The Altar of the Lord

Sermon by Pastor Zach Prosser

- Read Exodus 20:20-24
- The altar is such an important place; it is the place where God promised to meet with us, where he bestowed his name, his glory, and his presence.

Why is the altar important now, after Christ came and the veil was torn which separated us from God's presence? What significance does it have now, when God can meet us anywhere he chooses?

- Pastor Zach brought up the story of Moses asking God to "show me your glory" in Exodus 33 and 34. He pointed out that God shows his glory to Moses in the form of proclaiming his name and who he is:

"Then the Lord passed in front of Moses and called out: "The LORD, the LORD God, is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in loving devotion and truth, maintaining loving devotion to a thousand generations, forgiving iniquity, transgression, and sin...." (Exodus 34:6-7)

What do you think is significant about this? How is God's glory synonymous with his name and character?

Talk about what God has been doing in your life since he began revival at Celebration this summer.
