Giving Thanks

Sermon by Pastor Zach Prosser

In this time of giving thanks, it is especially important to remember and give praise and thanks for all God is and does. Take time in your discussion group to go over the passages below and talk about how you can give thanks specifically in each of these areas. Pray and give thanks together.

1 Thank him for his mercy (Ezra 3:11-13) - That we are not condemned to judgment for our sins but have been redeemed.

2 Thank him for his restoration - That he has and will restore as if they never happened. To be born again but ALSO to have abundant blessings and life.

3. Thank him for his defense (Psalm 28:7) - That he strengthens and sustains us in the midst of life and its trials and obstacles; he defends and protects us and fights on our behalf.

4. Thank him for his name (Psalm 44:8) - The power of his name to save, to bring life, to heal.

5. Thank him for his righteous laws (Psalm 119:62) - That he is in control, that his righteous law governs and directs our future and our everyday life. His law brings order to our life, lasts forever, and guides our lives.

6. Thank him for his supply (Matthew 15:36) - For his ability and power to provide out of nothing or out of the lack of your life. Yield your supply to God and he will give thanks over your life and multiply.

7. Thank him that he hears you (John 11:41) - That he has heard us even when it doesn't seem like an answer is there or is possible.

8. Thank him for victory (1 Corinthians 15:57) - That we don't have to fix everything on our own but that we can thank him for the victory, knowing he will provide it.

9. Thank him for spiritual family (1 Thessalonians 1:2) - Appreciating and blessing their strengths and gifts and the ability to work together for the kingdom.

10. Thank him for his rule and reign (Revelation 11:17) - That he rules over our lives, our governments, the earth and its seasons, and the future. That he is in control.
