Key Text: Luke 24:44-53

1. Clothed with Power (Luke 24:49)

- A. The word *endued* means “to be clothed with.”
- B. It is important to know how you are clothed.
- C. Joseph’s coat of many colors was a coat of favor and blessing (Genesis 37:3).

2. Being Clothed with Power Makes You Bold for God

- A. Peter spoke with boldness and the building shook (Acts 4:31).
- B. Stephen was full of boldness (Acts 6:8-15)

3. The Garment of Praise (Isaiah 61:3)

- A. We can carry the stench of our past, which is like the smell of ashes.
- B. The prodigal son (Luke 15:11-32).
 - i. The father putting a robe on his son is like God giving us a garment of praise (Luke 15:22).

4. The Robe of Righteousness (Isaiah 61:10).

- A. Jesus gives us a robe of righteousness.

5. Clothed with Gladness (Psalms 30:11)

- A. We are girded or bound by gladness.

6. Clothed with Christ (Romans 13:14)

- A. Wedding dresses must be perfect. There is no room for dirt or imperfection
- B. You are preparing for the Master’s coming. Are you clothed in the righteousness of Christ?
