

## Care Group Discussion Guide Celebration Church

### Key Text: Psalm 23:1-6

1. God will supply all our needs (v. 1).
  - a. He will never leave us or forsake us (Deuteronomy 31:6).
2. God makes us rest (v. 2).
  - a. We need to come into our Father's house without an agenda or work that needs to be done (Hebrews 4:1-10).
    - i. Just rest in His presence.
3. God provides proper nourishment for us (v. 2).
  - a. He doesn't bring us into fields ravaged by pestilence or containing leftover food.
  - b. We should feast on His word daily.
4. God restores us (v. 3).
  - a. He restores our soul after we have sinned.
  - b. He restores our emotions after they have gotten out of control.
    - i. We should be full of joy (Psalm 16:11).
5. God leads us in paths of righteousness (v. 3).
  - a. If you are walking in righteousness, the fruits of the Spirit will be evident (Galatians 5:22).
  - b. There is an aroma of righteousness (Ephesians 5:2).
6. God does all for His name's sake (v. 3).
  - a. Every knee shall bow to Jesus (Philippians 2:10-11).
7. God leads us out of the place of lack (v. 4).
  - a. The shadowland is a place of lack, barrenness, and brokenness.
    - i. If we are not careful, we could return to the shadowland after we have gone through it.
8. God keeps us safe (v. 4).
  - a. The rod is symbolic of correction.
    - i. Like children, many people run from God's correction, but He corrects us to keep us from harm.
9. God provides a feast for us (v. 5).
  - a. He provides more than what we need.
    - i. We are blessed to overflowing (Joel 2:24).
