

Care Group Discussion Guide

Celebration Church

Key Text: John 4:1-42

1. Jesus needed to go to Samaria to show them that He was the source of living water (v. 4).
2. All barriers of gender and race are removed in the presence of Jesus (v. 9).
3. We need to be thirsty for the living water of Jesus (v. 10).
4. The woman tried to figure out where Jesus was going to get the living water (v. 11).
 - a. We can't figure out how God is going to move. Also, just as Jesus did not need a waterpot to produce the living water, God doesn't need anything from us.
5. Jesus is an overflowing supply. He is all we need (v. 13).
6. The Samaritan woman was focused on the well and her duties, not the lifegiving water (v. 15).
7. The woman left her waterpot, which is symbolic of letting go of the control over her life and the control that her past had on her (v. 28).
 - a. Turn loose of your agenda and surrender your life to Jesus.
 - b. Our surrendered life doesn't add value to God, but it does show that Jesus is leading us.
8. Jesus revealed the woman's secrets (v. 28).
 - a. When you start drinking of the living water, you will be changed. Jesus goes into the deep parts of your life and affects everything.
