#### **Trust: A Confident expectation of something; hope**

##### A. Trusting God

1. We have to lose it all to gain it all (Matthew 10:37-39).
  - a. Why should we give it all up? Because of who He is.
2. You can't be a disciple unless you're willing to leave it all behind (Luke 14:33).
  - a. We must pay the cost of being a disciple of Christ (Luke 14:28).
  - b. The prize of discipleship is when God says, "Well done" (Matthew 25:21).
3. Where have you placed your trust?
  - a. Do you trust in your family, job, money, etc.?
  - b. We must not be drawn away from Christ to another love.
  - c. Many people have faith to believe God for a miracle, but they want it to happen their way.
4. Relationships
  - a. We may have to disassociate with people who are causing us to sin.
  - b. There are others who God brings into our lives to call us out or to call us to come up higher.
  - c. Saints who have gone before us are an encouragement to us (Hebrews 12:1).
5. The more we know God, the more we will trust Him.
  - a. We must have the mind of Christ (1 Corinthians 2:16).
  - b. God's thoughts are higher than ours (Isaiah 55:9).
6. The Lord knows what is in us, but He chooses us anyway (John 2:24-25).
  - a. The Lord knows what is in our minds and hearts (Matthew 9:4; Acts 1:24; John 18:4).
7. Jesus reveals the Father to us (Matthew 11:27).
