“I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.”

- Galatians 2:20

1) Crucified: Crucified with Christ = the place of no return

Romans 8:9-11, John 16:13-14, John 15:1-6, Ephesians 3:17, Galatians 3:3; 5:25; 6:14-16, Romans 6:2; 5-11

Discuss: Romans chapters 6 - 8 give us several Biblical reasons Christians have for not living in sin. What are some ways we can know as Christians that we are no longer bound to sin?

2) He lives IN ME – Get out of His way!

Galatians 5:16, Galatians 3:3, John 17:20-26, 2 Timothy 2:11, Hebrews 13:20, Acts 1:4,5, Philippians 2:13, 1 Thessalonians 2:13

Discuss: Discuss a time in your life when you were able to see God working through you by the Holy Spirit, and you knew it wasn't your own flesh working.

3) Who loved me

Romans 8:37-39, 1 John 4:8-10, 1 John 4:13; 18, Romans 5:5, Jeremiah 31:3, John 15:13, John 15:9
