Care Group Discussion Guide Celebration Church

- Jesus Revealed the Holy Spirit to His Disciples
 - Jesus was anointed with the Holy Spirit and power (Acts 10:38).
 - He told his disciples to wait on the promise of the Holy Spirit (Luke 24:49).
 - Jesus brought the Holy Spirit to them (John 20:19-22).
 - The word “saw” in verse 20 means “opening of the eyes.”

- What the Holy Spirit Does for Us
 - He empowers us to do great works (John 14:12-18).
 - He is our helper (John 14:16, 16:7; Romans 8:26).
 - The word “helper” in Greek is *parakletos* which means “comforter.”
 - The Greek word *Sunantilambanomai* means “to help in obtaining” or “to take hold with another.”
 - The Holy Spirit comes along side of us and helps us accomplish what God has called us to do.
 - He teaches us all things (John 14:26).
 - He guides us into all truth (John 16:13).
 - He convicts the world of sin (John 16:8).
 - The Holy Spirit brings conviction, not us.
 - He breathes life into us (Psalm 18:15; Revelation 11:11).
 - *Ruach Elohim* is Hebrew for “the wind or breath of God.”
 - On the Day of Pentecost, the Holy Spirit came as a mighty wind (Acts 2:1-2).
 - He intercedes on our behalf (Romans 8:26-27).
 - He will speak through us (John 6:63; Acts 4:31).
 - He will be with us always (John 14:18).

- How Should We Respond to the Holy Spirit
 - Continue daily in the works of the ministry (Acts 2:46).
 - Share the gospel with others (Acts 1:8).
 - Prophecy the blessings and promises of God for you and others (Revelation 19:10).
