- **The Holy Spirit is Our Comforter**
 - He comforts us in our afflictions (2 Corinthians 1:3-4).
 - The word “comfort” in Greek is *paraklesis*, which means “to come alongside to help and to give consolation or encouragement.”
 - The Holy Spirit comforts and multiplies the church (Acts 9:31).
 - Prophecy is comforting (1 Corinthians 14:3).
- **The Holy Spirit Gives us Peace**
 - The peace of God will comfort us (Philippians 4:6-7).
 - There is peace in knowing that the Holy Spirit is with us always (Psalm 139:7-10).
 - He guides, protects, and comforts us (Psalm 139:10).
- **The Holy Spirit Shows us the Love of God**
- The Holy Spirit puts God’s love into our hearts (Romans 5:5).
 - He testifies to us that we are the children of God (Romans 8:15-17).
 - He enables us to love God.
- **The Holy Spirit Gives us Rest**
 - Those who wait on the Lord shall be renewed (Isaiah 40:29-31).
 - Strive to enter the rest of God (Hebrews 4:9-11).
- **The Holy Spirit is Our Healer**
 - He gives life to our mortal bodies (Romans 8:11).
- **The Holy Spirit Expands our Boundaries**
 - He who is faithful with little will be given much (Luke 16:10; 19:17).
 - Peter’s faith was expanded when he walked on water (Matthew 14:28-31).
 - Peter probably didn’t feel the Holy Spirit, but he was empowered by Him.
 - The Holy Spirit can work through us even when we don’t feel Him.
