Jesus Baptizes in the Holy Spirit (John 20:19-22)

- The Holy Spirit is the Hebrew word *Ruach* which means “spirit,” “breath” or “wind.”
 - Ruach is seen in the creation of the world (Genesis 1:2.)
- The disciple’s eyes were opened, and they saw Jesus as the Messiah.
 - This is a salvation experience.
 - Baptism in the Holy Spirit is a part of God’s plan of salvation.

Jesus Told the Disciples to Wait for the Promise of the Father (Acts 1:4-8)

- God didn’t want to be separated from us, so He send His Holy Spirit.
- The Holy Spirit is to be received continually (Ephesians 5:15-18).
- He changes us from glory to glory (2 Corinthians 3:18).
- He pours out the love of God (Romans 5:5).
- He strengthens our inner man (Ephesians 3:16-19).
 - We need to know God’s love, which is the promise of the Father.
