Key Text: Isaiah 6:1-8

God Is Alive

- God reveals Himself to His people (1 John 1:1-2).
 - Position yourself to see God by living a holy life.
 - When you see Him it changes everything.
- Jesus makes intercession for us (Romans 8:34).

God is Authoritative

- God created all things for His glory (Colossians 1:15-17; Revelation 11:15).
- The works of the flesh and the fruit of the Spirit can't co-exist (Galatians 5:19-23).

God is All Powerful

- God can do all things (Job 42:2; Jeremiah 32:17).
- God's purpose will be accomplished (Isaiah 46:10).
- Our help comes from God (Psalm 121:2).

God is Most Attractive

- There is fulness and satisfaction in God (John 1:16; Psalm 36:8).
- The anointing of Jesus (John 12:1-3).
 - The oil that Mary poured on Jesus would cost \$30,000 today.
 - This is passionate worship that doesn't hold anything back.

God is Holy

- The ground is holy wherever God is (Exodus 3:5).
- His holiness is His utterly unique, divine, transcendent, and pure essence; which in His uniqueness has infinite value. It determines all that He is and does and is determined by no one. His holiness is what He is as God, which no one else is or ever will be. Call it His majesty, His divinity, His supreme greatness, or His value as the pearl of great price. He is HOLY, HOLY, HOLY!

God is Glorious

- The glory of God is all-consuming (Exodus 24:17, 40:34; 1 Kings 8:11; Luke 2:9).

How We Should Respond to the Glory of God

- Repentance
 - This is a continual act (Luke 5:32; Acts 11:18).
- Worship
 - This is a continual act (Hebrew 10:1-2, 13:5).
- Commission
 - Go into the world and preach the gospel (Mark 16:15; Matthew 28:19; Acts 1:8).
