Key Text: John 6:15-35

After the Feeding of the 5,000 (John 6:1-14)

- The disciples went to Capernaum, which means “city of comfort” (John 6:17).
 - They sought comfort instead of the comforter (Psalm 91:4-6).
 - Seek first the kingdom of God and all your needs will be met (Matthew 6:33).

What Happens When Jesus Distances Himself and a Storm Comes

- When you don’t feel Jesus like you did before, He is still there (Matthew 28:19-20).

Meet Jesus in the Secret Place (Psalm 91:1-2)

- We can overcome the world through Jesus (John 16:33).

Jesus is the Bread of Heaven (John 6:35)

- Only Jesus satisfies, not the things of the world (Isaiah 55:1-2; John 7:37).
 - Jesus changes our desires from natural food to spiritual food (John 6:26-27).
 - He came not to be useful but to be precious.
 - He is an eternal supply (John 4:14).
