### **Key Text: Psalm 27:1-14**

- **There is No Fear in God's Presence (Psalm 27:1; 23:1-6)**
  - God is a ray of righteousness and the light of our salvation.
  
- **Life Events and People Have No Power Over Us (Psalm 27:2-3)**
  - David spoke the word of God to Goliath (I Samuel 17:45-47).
    - We need to use the word of God to speak to our enemies and problems.
  
- **Our Desire Should Be to Dwell in God's House (Psalm 27:4)**
  - The "house" David speaks of is a tent, not a temple.
    - We should not seek the beauty of a building or people, but God's presence.
  
- **We Need to Wait on God (Psalm 27:14)**
  
- **How Do We Dwell in God's House?**
  - Recognize that it is His house, not ours.
    - God hosts us in His house, but we need to steward it (I Peter 4:10).
    - We are to do God's will in His house (Philippians 2:12-13).
  - Know what God requires in His house.
    - Holiness (Psalm 24:3-4; Matthew 5:8).
    - Repentance (Psalm 51:10-11).
    - A cleansed conscience (Hebrews 9:14).
    - Our bodies used for His glory (Romans 12:1).
