Celebration Church Care Group Discussion Guide The Fog of Deception

HOSPITALITY

Take time to welcome each other to group and share about your week.

ICE BREAKER

Discuss the question: Sunday's message from Pastor Zach and our pastoral team was a call to examine our hearts. God is doing a new thing in this season. How does self-examination and repentance prepare us for all that God is doing?

BIBLE DISCUSSION

- 1. The meaning of deception is lying, misleading, hiding, and distorting by denying, omitting, fabricating, minimizing, or exaggerating. What are some common examples of deception?
- 2. The Bible gives us examples of deception and the judgment that results. Take time to review these examples, how God's judgment came, and what restoration God brought:
 - a. Genesis 3: The Fall of Man and how it demonstrates James 1:14-15 Life Cycle of Sin
 - b. Numbers 12:1,10: Miriam and Aaron speaking against Moses
 - c. Numbers 16:23-35: Korah's Rebellion
 - d. Numbers 20:12: Moses strikes the rock
 - e. 2 Chronicles 26:16-21: King Uzziah's rebellion
 - f. Acts 5: Ananias & Saphhira
 - g. Acts 19:3: 7 Sons of Sceva
 - h. Numbers 21; John 3:14-16: The Fiery Serpents

 - g. 2 Timothy 3:13-15
 - h. Galatians 3:1-3
 - i. 2 Corinthians 11:14-15

4. Deception's Description

- a. Blinding like a fog
- b. Produce lethargy and spiritual apathy
- c. Appeals to the things known to be true, and is mixed with lies and manipulation
- d. Leads down a path of destruction
- e. Disorienting and eventually brings confusion
- f. Like witchcraft, deception produces rebellion to the truth and God's authority
- g. Seems mesmerizing and fascinating, a person of charisma and charm
- h. Shifts us from God's work in us to my work and traditions of man
