ICE BREAKER

Discuss the question: What did God speak to you on Sunday from Pastor's message on speaking in tongues?

BIBLE DISCUSSION

- 1. Read Acts 2:1-21; Isaiah 28:11-12; 44:3; Ephesians 5:18
- 2. Pastor Zach taught on the Biblical reasons for praying in tongues. Take time to review each of these and discuss the Biblical evidence and how these can be applied in your personal life:
 - a. Restoration of Divine Communication
 - i. 1 Corinthians 14:2, 14-15
 - ii. Isaiah 55:8
 - b. Unity & Fellowship
 - i. Jude 1:20-21
 - ii. Comparison between the Tower of Babel (Genesis 11) and the Day of Pentecost (Acts 2)
 - iii. Psalm 133
 - c. Builds Yourself up in Your Holy Faith
 - i. Jude 1:20
 - ii. Praying until the Glory comes
 - d. Brings Edification
 - i. 1 Corinthians 14:4
 - ii. Edify brick by brick builds and assimilates God's Word into our lives
 - e. Brings Victory over our Weaknesses
 - i. Romans 8:26-28
 - ii. Helps Sunantilambanomai
 - f. We Pray God's Will for Ourselves
 - i. Romans 8:26
 - ii. Our natural prayers are often affected by our natural emotions and intellect.

 Tongues prays God's will no matter how we feel or what we see in the natural.
 - g. We Intercede for Others
 - i. Romans 8:27

- h. We Pray According to the Will of God
 - i. Romans 8:27
- i. We See God Working on our Behalf
 - i. Romans 8:28
 - ii. Paul connects praying in the Spirit to knowing and realizing God's plan for our good
