❖ Led by the Spirit

- Matthew 4:1 TPT Afterward, the Holy Spirit led Jesus into the wilderness to experience the ordeal of testing by the accuser.
- Luke 4:1 TPT From the moment of his baptism, Jesus <u>overflowed</u> with the Holy Spirit.
 He was taken by the Spirit from the Jordan into the wilderness of Judea to experience for forty days the ordeal of testing by the accuser.
- Tempted = disciplined
 - Jesus was led by the Spirit into battle, and then used the Sword of the Spirit (The Word) to fight
 - How can we use scripture in our daily lives to overcome the things we face?
- Full: opposite of depleted or imperfect; not lacking He was complete and lacking nothing
 - Acts 6:3; Ephesians 5:18; John 16:13
 - Discuss ways we can be 'full' of the Spirit in our day to day lives
 - What are some things that can distract us or cause us to not live 'full'
